† Proxy is a direct count of items (fee envelopes, ski ticket sales, room rental receipts, sites occupied, traffic counts, etc.) that represents recreation visitation to a Forest Service site or area by an individual, a group, or a vehicle. The forest reported this number and NVUM data was used to convert the proxy count into a Site Visit estimate.
