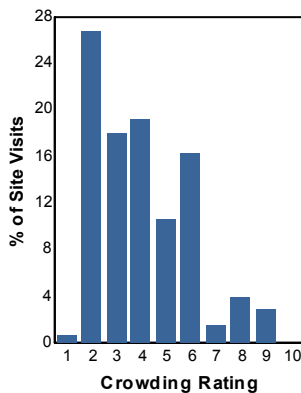

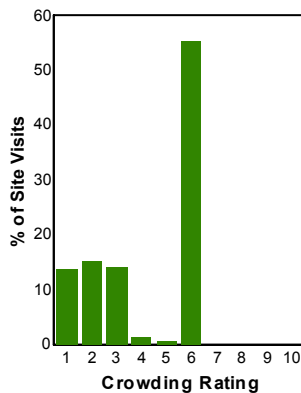

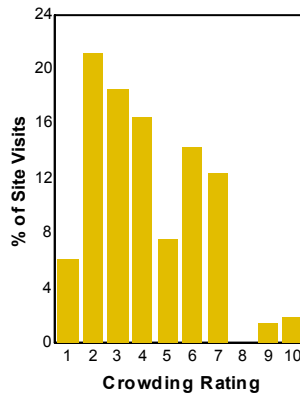
Day Use Developed Sites



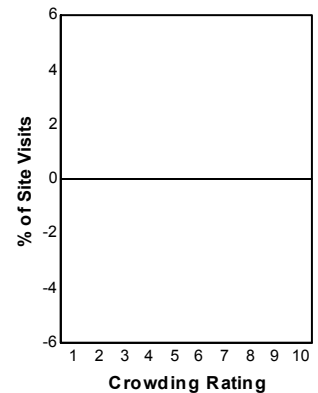
Overnight Use Developed Sites
