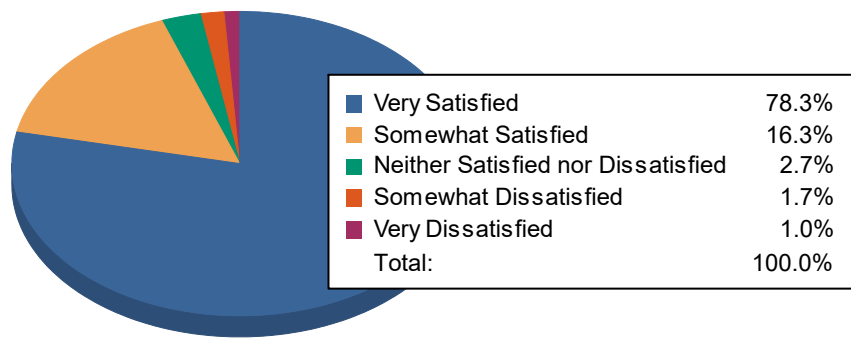


Percent of National Forest Visits by Overall Satisfaction Rating



Selected Regions:

Northern Region (R1) (FY 2005, FY 2006, FY 2007, FY 2008, FY 2009)
Rocky Mountain Region (R2) (FY 2005, FY 2006, FY 2007, FY 2008, FY 2009)

A National Forest Visit is defined as the entry of one person upon a national forest to participate in recreation activities for an unspecified period of time. A National Forest Visit can be composed of multiple Site Visits.

Calculations are computed using weights that expand the sample of individuals to the population of National Forest Visits.
